Greetings to all of our loyal inspectors. Welcome to new inspectors that will be working for the first time. You could be called to work 3 elections this year. A Federal Primary in June, a State and Local Primary in September, and a General Election in November.

We have been reviewing some of your suggestions and making some changes for the upcoming elections to improve and refine the voting process. Please read your Inspector Manuals on Election Day. You will find current maps and useful information within.

The numbering process as voters arrive has been simplified and the paperwork at the end of the night will be

much clearer. That seems to be where most of the changes will be noticeable.

We have consolidated election districts in some towns. (see page 2) This change will simply bring voters to a new table.

All polling sites remain the same for voters.

We will share more details at our new and improved inspector training this Spring and Summer. Please call the BOE for available classes. They always fill up fast!

REMINDER: The June 24 Federal Primary will allow Republican voters in the 22nd Congressional District (south of the river) to choose a candidate for the General Election.

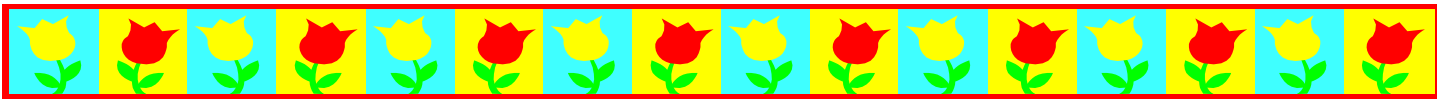

AFFIDAVITS

A little refresher about Affidavit ballots:

- First call the BOE so we can verify the voter is in the correct district.
- Voter is given an affidavit ballot & envelope.
- When the voter gives the envelope back, make sure it is completely filled out, signed, and sealed.
- The Inspector must then fill in the Town and E.D. at the bottom of the envelope
- Fill in the Challenge Report with the complete voter's name and address
- Place the voter's completed Affidavit into the Affidavit envelope.
- Affidavit ballots NEVER go through the voting machine.



ELECTION DISTRICT CHANGES FOR BARTON, CANDOR, OWEGO, & TIOGA

BARTON WAVERLY VILLAGE HALL

Voters from Districts 1,2, &3 will be voting at the Waverly Village Hall. BA8 has been absorbed into BA2. The voters formerly from BA8 will simply vote at BA2 table.

BARTON BARTON TOWN HALL

Voters from Districts 4 & 7 will be voting at the Barton Town Hall. BA6 has been absorbed into BA4. The voters formerly from BA6 will simply vote at the BA4 table.

CANDOR CANDOR FIRE STATION

Voters from Districts 1,3,4 will be voting at the Candor Fire Station. CA5 has been absorbed into CA4. The voters formerly from CA5 will simply vote at the CA4 table.

TIOGA TIOGA TOWN HALL

Voters from District 2 will be voting at the Tioga Town Hall. TI3 has been absorbed into TI2. The voters formerly from TI3 are now TI2 voters.

OWEGO OWEGO MIDDLE SCHOOL

Voters from Districts 6,7,10 will be voting at the Owego Middle School. OW9 has been absorbed into OW6. The voters formerly from OW9 will simply vote at the OW6 table.

OWEGO PARK TERRACE CHURCH

Voters from Districts 15 & 17 will be voting at Park Terrace Church. OW20 has been absorbed into OW17. OW21 has been absorbed into OW15.

\$\$\$ PAYDAY \$\$\$

Elections Inspectors receive \$160.00 for working at the General Election and \$110.00 for working at the Primary Election.

All inspectors receive an additional \$25.00 for attending the inspector training classes.

Chairperson receives additional \$25.00 for Election Day service. Checks are usually sent approximately one month after the election.
